





31.3 million kg of primary materials have been avoided

That equals 3.1 times the weight of **the Eiffel Tower** (10,000 tons)

Or the weight of over 20,000 average cars (1,500 kg each)





2.9 million kg of CO2 emissions have been avoided

It would take **145,750 trees** one full year to absorb the same amount of CO₂

That's equivalent to 364 km of roadside trees — nearly the distance **from Middelburg to Paris**!

Or a forest of **44.8 hectares** (assuming 3,250 trees per hectare)

Monitoring and Offsetting CO2 Emissions:

Since 2012, Zeeland has monitored its annual CO2 emissions and offsets them through contributions to the **Zeeland Climate Fund**.

Responsible Procurement:

Our **responsible procurement plan** prioritizes suppliers offering sustainable products such as organic or reusable materials, which help reduce CO2 emissions.

Electrification of the Fleet:

Specialized vehicles (quarterdeck wagons) will transition to **HVO 100 biofuel** by 2025.

Green Energy and Sustainable Buildings:

Active use of **green electricity** and **green gas**. Retrofitting buildings for energy efficiency by improving insulation and installing solar panels.

Energy-Efficient Infrastructure:

Public lighting & traffic systems upgraded with LED technology for energy savings.

Robust Knowledge & Innovation Network for Circular Construction

A triple-helix knowledge, development, and cooperation center bringing together the Province, businesses, and scientists.














Leading fields of expertise




