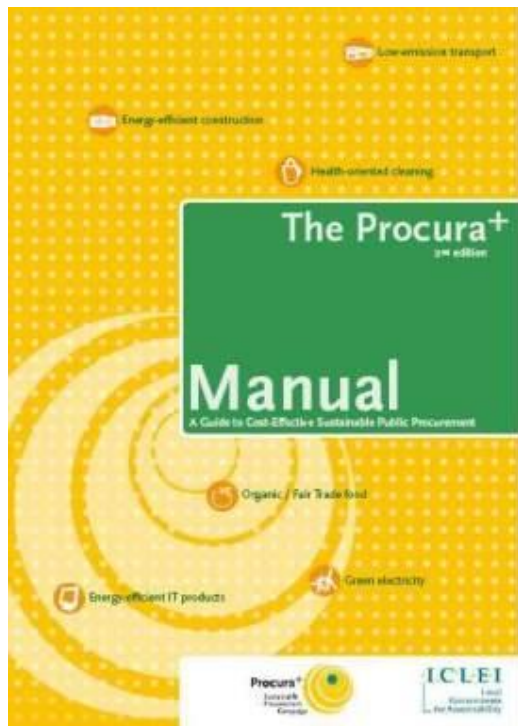

- **Kolding Municipality** – SRPP award criteria for the renting and laundering of workwear
- **City of Barcelona:** mandatory SPP criteria for 10 categories
- **City of Malmo** – „white jobs“ initiative in cooperation with unions
- **City of Ghent** strategic approach to SPP & EcoProcura 2014
- **Reseau Grand Ouest (RGO)** – 99 municipalities, workshops and guidance, most recently cleaning products and biogas
- **Ecoinstitut** – running training activities for GPP2020, input to EU GPP Helpdesk webinars and case studies
