

Solution: Circular and sustainable coughing screens instead of plastic coughing screens between the working places.

The screens are made from pure, unmixed materials. To further shield the environment, the company chooses suppliers in the immediate area and thereby reducing transportation distances. The screens are made of felt and are sound absorbent.
