- Collaborate on verification methods, such as monitoring and evaluating mechanisms, for ensuring suppliers are meeting socially responsible contractual obligations.

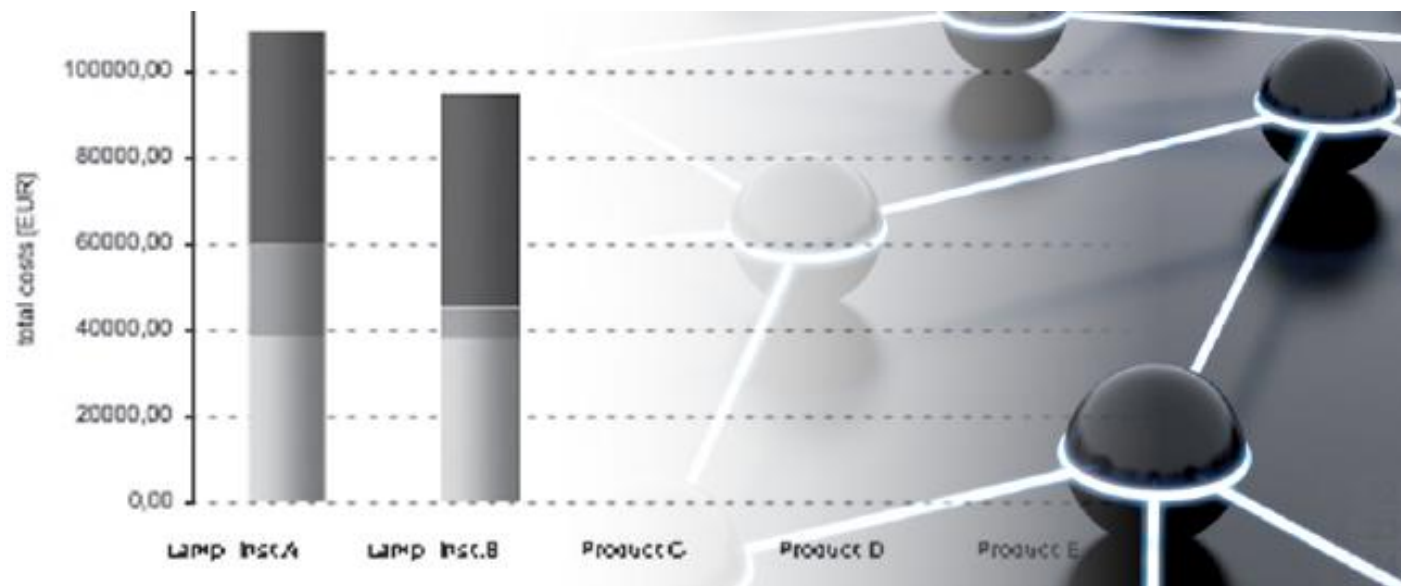
